In its six degrees of separation, mental health issues, touch almost every single person in the region.

Now more than ever is the time to be vigilant and aware of the challenges that the Region and many other regions throughout Ontario are facing in trying to address the systemic issues in coping with and managing mental health. The report addresses the need to take an interdisciplinary and collaborative approach in meeting the needs of those impacted by mental health issues and concerns.

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As an agency whose programs are supported by the Region of Peel, we would concur with the

25 recommendations that are outlined in the document. FAME remains hopeful that the Select

Committee on Mental Health and Addictions for the Province of Ontario will take note of this

valuable report, prompting a new phase of action.
